



How to find us

Muswell Hill Methodist Church is in Pages Lane, Muswell Hill N10, a turning off Colney Hatch Lane (B550), easily accessible from the North Circular Road (A406), or, from central London, off the A1 at Highgate.

Our buildings are set back from the road and there is a high wall so you may not be able to see the building until you get to the gate.

There is limited parking usually available at the church, as well as free on-street parking in the area.

Bus

Routes 134 (from Tottenham Court Road) and 43 (from Moorgate) both stop on Colney Hatch Lane. Other routes shown below.

North Bank, part of Muswell Hill Methodist Church on Pages Lane, is a fine Victorian villa, an oasis of peace in beautiful landscaped grounds.

The house is light, bright and spacious, fully modernised and accessible, with up-to-date kitchens, equipment and wi-fi. Its extensive rooms make an attractive venue for receptions, meetings, training, music or dance, and the largest room can accommodate groups of up to 100 people. There is level access to the garden, a lift to all floors and, for amplifying the spoken word, an audio loop system in the two larger rooms.

Our aims

We aim to provide a place of opportunity for all where every person is valued, so we can contribute to the community life of the neighbourhood and the wellbeing of local residents.

Our rooms

Most of our rooms overlook the grounds of the North Bank Estate. On the ground floor there is a small lounge, seating 12, and a large reception room opening out onto the garden, with a capacity of 80-100; upstairs, an oak panelled room for up to 60 people and four meeting rooms suitable for 12-20 people on the first floor; and a two-room self-contained attic suite on the second floor for up to 15 people.

All rooms have chairs and tables and all are carpeted, except for the Garden Room which has a wood block floor.

You are welcome to come and view our rooms to see if any are suitable for you. Just give us a call first to check availability.

Facilities

The building is normally open and available for hire from 9.00 am - 10.00pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive. However, we only have very restricted availability before 1.30pm on Saturday.

We do not take bookings on Sundays to give priority to church activities.

Our room hire charge includes

- Use of kitchen facilities to make hot and cold drinks
- Folding tables of varying heights and sizes
- Various styles of chair including small ones for children
- Flip charts (but please bring your own paper and pens)
- TV and DVD player in the Oak Room (by prior arrangement)
- Acoustic piano in the Garden Room (by prior arrangement)

Use of the church garden and Estate grounds

We share the North Bank grounds with other organisations on the estate and our use of the grounds is subject to negotiation. You must ensure that children are very well supervised when outside, both for their own safety and to prevent any damage to trees and flowerbeds. Please do not book an event that relies on the use of the grounds without discussing this with us first.

Catering

You are welcome to bring in your own food and supplies, but if you wish to make full use of the kitchen, there is a small additional charge - unless you only need to make hot or cold drinks. **Please note alcohol must not be brought onto or consumed on our premises even at private events.**

How we work

The building is run by volunteers who offer a warm welcome, and provide high quality facilities for a wide range of activities: space for quiet days; privacy for counselling or interviews; a happy, safe and comfortable place to work for charities, community organisations and small business; a base for local health, education and social services projects; a location for performance and rehearsals; and for children's groups. We work in partnership with voluntary organisations and statutory services, as well as with other churches, to achieve our aims.

We put the income from lettings back to work in the community - to help pay for the community services run by the Church - Baby Talk; a Toddler Group; a Child Contact Centre; and the Vintage Club for older people - as well as for new projects.

We are open to new ideas and initiatives and value suggestions and feedback from our visitors and users to help us continue to improve the service we offer.
